

PROGRAM NOTE

Tellings is a piece for Symphonic Band written in the typical stylistic structure of the narrative, a story whose protagonist is the listener. Just as in the works of the famous painter Vassily Kandisky a specific message is associated eith each color, in this composition an initial fanfare acts as a prelude to a continuos alteration between periods of action and reflection marked by the sudden change of colors generated by the interwinning of the sections and of the individual instruments.
